

Playing Rules

Salina Fieldhouse 10U Indoor Tournament



Revised 3/18/24

Teams will use all USA Fastpitch rules and regulations with the following exceptions or notes:

Official Ball: Red-stitch ASA/USA Stamped 11" Optic Yellow .47 COR/375 Ball (No USSSA Blue-stitch balls will be used)

Pitching Distance: The pitching distance shall be 35 feet.

Time Limit: Pool & Bracket games will be 7 innings or 65 minutes, finish the inning. Game time begins with the 1st warm up pitch. Umpires on the field will keep the official time. Pool games can end in a tie.

Runs Per Inning Limit: 6 runs or 3 outs, whichever occurs 1st.

Game Ending Run Rules: 12 after 3 innings, 10 after 4 innings, 8 after 5 innings.

Tie-Breaker Rule in Bracket Games: At the end of the 7th inning or after time expires for both teams. The offensive team shall begin its turn at bat with the player who is scheduled to bat last in that respective half inning being placed on 2nd base.

Batting Lineups: 10's will bat their complete, full roster for all games, pool, and bracket.

Players in the field and on defense: 10's will have 9 players that will play on defense in the field, with 3 of them positioned in the outfield.

Player-Pitcher: 10's: Regular pitcher. No coach-pitcher.

Batter: 10's: On a Base on Balls or Walk, the Batter is awarded 1st Base and CANNOT advance further than 1st base on a walk. The batter is OUT on a dropped 3rd strike. The batter CANNOT run or advance to 1st base on a dropped 3rd strike. **Infield Fly Rule is in play for 10's.**

Base Runner: 10's: Players can steal 2nd or 3rd base but **cannot steal home**. One (1) stolen base per pitch is allowed. Runners **cannot** advance past the base they are attempting to steal, if there is an overthrow to the base the runner is attempting to steal.

Defensive Substitutions: Players may be freely substituted on defense.

Strike Zone: The strike zone shall be enlarged, when the player is in a natural stance, to include the top of the shoulders to mid-shin. The strike zone shall also be enlarged to include the width of a softball on each side of home plate.

Scorekeepers: Home team will be the official scorebook. Visiting team will run the score board. Neither of these will apply if the Tournament provides an official scorekeeper.

Protests: The Home Plate Umpire and the Official Scorekeeper must be notified of a protest at the time of the infraction and prior to the next pitch, legal or illegal. No appeals will be heard after this point. Protests on an umpire's judgement will not be heard. The Tournament Director and/or UIC shall give the final rule interpretation.

Jewelry: Exposed jewelry, which is judged by the umpire, to be dangerous, will not be permitted and will be removed. Medical alert items are not considered jewelry. Medical alert items that are worn must be taped to the body so medical alert information remains visible.

Salina Fieldhouse “Indoor Ground Rules”

- + If a batted ball hits the ceiling netting, in foul territory, it is a foul ball and can be caught for an out.
- + If a batted ball hits the ceiling netting, in fair territory, it can be caught for an out or played as a fair, playable ball, if not caught.
- + Batted balls that become “stuck” in the ceiling netting in foul territory, will be ruled a dead ball/foul ball.
- + Batted balls that become “stuck” in the ceiling netting in fair territory, will be ruled a dead ball/one (1) base award to the batter. Base runners may advance one (1) base, but only if they are forced.
- + Batted balls that are either hit or roll beyond the “Taped Outfield Netting” will be ruled a Ground Rule Double. Batted balls hit over the “dividing wall” between fields will be ruled a home run.
- + **Shoes: No steel spiked shoes on any turf field. Plastic molded cleated turf field shoes are allowed. Regular gym or athletic shoes with flat soles, preferred.**
