I began to get extremely thirsty and started to wet the bed at night. My mom's friend mentioned something about diabetes symptoms, so my parents took me to the doctor. After a blood stick on the finger, test results showed that I needed to get to Children's Mercy Hospital...ASAP. I was very lucky that they caught this diagnosis in time. I could have gone into DKA (Diabetic Ketoacidosis) or a diabetic coma. I am thankful someone told my parents about the warning signs.*

*Living with T1D is a roller-coaster of highs and lows, physical and emotional challenges, and just learning how to manage this unpredictable disease. But I will not let T1D hold me back! I've played softball since I was 5 yrs old. Unfortunately, there were several times that I had to sit out to fix my blood sugar level. I really hate all the needles and insulin. My dream is to find a cure for all kids living with T1D, so we don't ever have to sit on a bench because of this disease."*
