- Anyone ejected from the game coaches, players or spectators, will not be allowed to participate or be a spectator at the next game.
- Individuals and/or team will be flagged and identified for possible suspension from future USA Softball events.

Tournament Directors

On-site directors will take the appropriate actions as outlined above. On-site directors are also responsible for reporting the incident to the KC Metro JO Commissioner immediately for possible further action.

USA Softball of Kansas City reserves the right to adjust our policies at any time based on updated information as may be found in the USA Softball National Code or in a manner that best serves the needs of the participants of USA Softball of Kansas City.
